

General Rules (Applicable to all students)

- In order to achieve maximum improvement students are expected to attend and participate in a full schedule at the school. The times and dates of the TGSE schedule and each student's individual training sessions will be posted on the notice board in the TGSE academy room.
- Should a student miss any scheduled session, including coaching, fitness, lecture, matchplay game or any other scheduled session, without a valid reason, prior notice and permission from the Elite Performance Director, that student will be ineligible for that week's medal tournament. Should this happen twice in a cycle that student shall be ineligible for the 72-hole championship.
- Students will arrive strictly on time for all scheduled training sessions and tournaments. Traffic delays are not regarded as a valid excuse. It is the student's responsibility to obtain his starting time for tournaments.
- Good manners, respect, discipline & sportsmanship should be characteristics of all TGSE students. Excessive and offensive profanity will not be tolerated.
- TGSE Students must maintain the facilities utilized by TGSE including but not exclusively the golf courses, practice facilities and clubhouse areas in a neat and tidy state at all times.
- Any student causing damage to the grounds and property of TGSE, Royal Johannesburg & Kensington Golf Club or Observatory Driving Range will be appropriately punished and will be liable for the repair of such damage.
- TGSE Students must act in an accountable and responsible manner at all times.
- TGSE students must act at all times in a manner that promotes the culture of improvement for all at the school.
- TGSE Students must wear suitable golfing attire at all times during practice and play, as laid out in the TGSE student handbook. Students incorrectly attired will not be able to participate in school activities, including tournament play, until they are correctly attired.
- Smoking will not be permitted at any time during the school schedule, including on -course and tournament play, and / or on the premises of Royal Johannesburg & Kensington GC or Observatory GC at any time whatsoever.
- Alcohol will not be permitted at any time during the schedule, or whilst representing TGSE, including after tournament play. Students are prohibited from consuming alcohol at Royal Johannesburg & Kensington GC or Observatory GC at any time whatsoever.
- The use of illegal drugs is strictly forbidden at any time during a student's training at TGSE.
- During tournament play, students will follow the rules & regulations as laid out in the TGSE Tournament Policy. Cheating during tournament play will not be tolerated.
- Behavior that has a negative effect on either the atmosphere of the school or on another student will not be tolerated.
- Gambling is strictly prohibited at the school.
